

PASTOR CARE - General Phone Call Script

VISION: To pastor the people entrusted to us with every phone call through knowing, loving, and meeting needs.

- Know them by listening, seek to understand, listen again
- Loving them praying with them and by speaking truth
- Meeting needs document data & email to Pastor Josh Homan and Karen Murano

Our endeavor in this season is to make a 3CX phone call to our church family members. Please log every call by summarizing how you prayed with them and if they have any needs. Using the Google Sheets (spreadsheet) under the appropriate tab (your name) add the details directly onto the list you are managing. Take notes in a such a way that if this person was handed to another leader they could pick up where you left off to continue the pastoral care. This document updates online in real-time as you make changes and is shared among the team, please only work on the list in your tab.

- → Log ALL your notes here: Call List Google Sheet (working the list under your name/tab)
- → Copy and send NEEDS for further review in an email to Pastor Josh and Karen Murano

Leave them with HOPE!

Each time you begin -

- Pray first, ask the Lord to give you wisdom and to speak through you.
- Open the Google Sheets document and your email; be ready to take notes.
- If a practical need comes up, under promise and over deliver.
- Lead with LOVE, have go-to scriptures available to share. (see below)

Answered Calls: (Know them, love them, meet their needs)
Hello, may I please speak to []? This is [] from Next Level Church, and I am part of the Pastoral Care Team. Do you have a minute or two to talk?
→ If no: Ask if there is a better time to call – note the day / time
→ If yes: Proceed with the script or use the <u>talking points,</u> as they are appropriate:

"As your church family, we just wanted to check in and see how you're doing. We believe that now, maybe more than ever, staying connected is vital and truly makes a difference. Have you been able to connect with us online or in a small Group?"

- → "How are you doing?"
- → "How has your world changed?"
- → "Do you have kids in your home?" "Have you seen NL Kids has online resources?" "Collide, too!"
- → "God loves you."
- \rightarrow "We love you, and you're not alone."
- → "Is there any way we can pray for you?"

PRAY FOR THEM!

• Encourage them to participate in an online weekend service.

- Invite to join the prayer time at 7:14 PM daily on a social media platform: Instagram or Facebook LIVE
- Enter any prayer requests they give you on the Google Sheet and be sure to pray for them over the phone.
- If they have expressed any practical needs, please document them in your <u>Call List Google Sheet</u> and add copy the needs in an email separately.
